DIGITAL STORYTELLING

10 – 13 August

We all have stories in our lives. *Digital Stories* are short, personal, multimedia tales that are told from the heart and anyone can make them, even you. Tell a tale about anything you wish; love, work, hopes, fears, the past, present and future, the most important thing is that it is your story. If there's something that sticks in your mind, something you feel strongly about, a place you love (or hate!) then that could be the basis of a digital story. Participants are led through the process step-by-step and previous computer knowledge is not essential. Think about what images and sounds you can use to illustrate your story; photos, objects or music – and bring these to the workshop. The finished results will premiere at a special Mercury Cinema screening and will also be included as a short before the *Seniors on Screen* feature films. Book early to avoid missing out on this incredible opportunity to create a lasting personal document.

SENIORS FILMMAKING BOOTCAMP

28 September – 2 October

Another big *Seniors on Screen* success story in 2008, the *Seniors Filmmaking Bootcamp* is an intensive five-day hands-on introduction to filmmaking from concept to screen. In five days participants are taught the basics of filmmaking covering scriptwriting, shooting, sound recording and editing, and then get to make a film themselves as part of a team. The finished results will premiere at a special Mercury Cinema screening and each film will also be included as a short before the *Seniors on Screen* feature films.
